Resolution 2-01

WHEREAS, The Montana District devoted time to the study of the Formula of Concord, Epitome at its 2022 District Convention; and

WHEREAS, This confession placed special emphasis on the teaching of the Law and the Gospel by saying, in part, "We believe, teach and confess that the distinction between the Law and the Gospel is to be kept in the Church with great diligence as a particularly brilliant light." (Formula of Concord Epitome Art. V.); and

WHEREAS, Without the proper distinction of Law and Gospel the Holy Scriptures remain a closed book¹; and

WHEREAS, The suggestion has been made that "two kinds of righteousness" is a better paradigm than law and gospel for preaching and teaching, which suggestion has caused discussion around our synod; and

WHEREAS, The law/gospel structure of sermons has been cast as outdated in some circles, in favor of more creative rhetorical approaches; and

WHEREAS, As few as 34% of the teachers in the K-12 school of our Synod are rostered Lutheran teachers²; and

WHEREAS, This "particularly brilliant light" offers a key understanding of the "Good News" to both catechumens and seasoned believers; therefore be it

Resolved, That delegates to the 2022 Montana District Convention rejoice in being renewed in this article of doctrine by sharing it in their reports to their congregations; and

Resolved, That Pastors and teachers of the Montana District be encouraged to keep this teaching with great diligence through proper instruction and supervision; and

Resolved, That pastors of churches in the Montana District which operate schools engage with school leaders to ensure that teachers are instructed in the proper application of Law and Gospel in teaching; and be it finally

Resolved, That pastors of churches in the Montana District which operate schools engage with school leaders to ensure that teachers receive adequate supervision in the proper application of Law and Gospel in teaching.
