To Amend the Montana District Bylaws to Provide for the Care of an Outgoing District President in a Manner Consistent with the Care Given by Synod to an Outgoing President

## **Resolution 5-01**

WHEREAS, Montana District Bylaw 2.2.1.4.c reads "If the District President is not reelected, he shall continue to receive his full salary and benefits for a period not to exceed ninety days from the day the newly elected President takes office. If he finds other employment, accepts a call, or retires before the end of ninety days, his salary and benefits from the District shall end by the first of the month following his assumption of such employment, call, or retirement"; and

WHEREAS, The equivalent bylaw (3.2.4.1.a-b) in the Synod bylaws provides for an outgoing President for a period of six months while rendering transitional service; therefore be it

Resolved, That Bylaw 2.2.1.4.c of the District Bylaws be amended as follows:

2.2.1.4.c If the District President is not re-elected, he shall continue to receive his full salary and benefits for a period not to exceed six months from the day the newly elected President takes office, while rendering transitional service. If he finds other employment, accepts a call, or retires before the end of six months, his salary and benefits from the District shall end by the first of the month following his assumption of such employment, call, or retirement.
